We began April by hosting our very first **Seder Service!** On April 5th, we moved in twenty tables and transformed the Tapestry into a giant “upper room.” A Seder service or Passover Meal is the Jewish ritual feast held on the first night of the Jewish holiday of Passover. It is the same meal that Jesus and his disciples ate on the night that he was betrayed (also known as the Last Supper.) Aphikomen? Matzah? Marrow? Kiddush? Charoset? New words and a new experience for many at the Tapestry, but deep in symbolism and metaphor! It was enjoyed by all, especially by the senior men who had the task of hiding the Matzah from the kids! The week after, we remembered Jesus’ sacrifice on Good Friday by reflecting upon the seven last words that Jesus spoke on the cross. It was a quiet reflective candle-lit service consisting of readings, prayer, and silence.
